

PMHCA PROGRAM NEWS

PMHCA has been awarded a grant through the Department of Drug and Alcohol Programs called *The* Recovery Hub. PMHCA will collect data through a needs assessment in the thirteen counties in region five, to create a comprehensive overview of issues in those counties. The Institute at Wilkes University will utilize secondary sources from the state and federal government to better understand the extent of these needs from the initial assessment. Then a strategic plan will be created to address those needs the assessments identify and will be implemented in the thirteen counties. PMHCA and PaPSC will provide technical support to the region during this project.

TRAINING SPOTLIGHT

On August 2nd thru the 4th, PMHCA will be offering Forensic Peer Support. Individuals in this class will utilize the new curriculum to explore ethics, trauma informed care, and the sequential intercept model to create diversion programs that they can implement in their communities. 


YOUTH MOVE PA NEWS




YMPA Podcast

Youth and Young Adult Peer Support As Certified Peer Professionals, we continue our healing and recovery journey every day. This workshop allows for more growth and understanding of trauma, how it applies to us as humans, how we can apply it to our professional life, and why self-care matters.




Training Department Details

The training department is excited to announce their summer enhancement series. In July, we will be offering Trauma Sensitive Peer: Continuing our Journey, a class focused on understanding trauma, using your story to inspire hope in a safe manner, and receiving stories in a manner that reduces vicarious trauma. In August. Forensic Peer Support will be offered virtually. The new curriculum has been completed for this course and will be offered in the August class. Individuals will learn about the sequential intercept model and how to implement diversion programs in their community. Lastly in August, we will be offering Youth and Young Adult Peer support. This three-day course will teach individuals how to interact with youth in a ethical manner while providing peer support to this specialized population.
